The Commission has voted to approve a Memorandum and Order which denies the intervention petitions of the California Public Utilities Commission, the County of San Luis Obispo, and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of PG&E, but grants California Public Utilities Commission and the the County of San Luis Obispo participant status in this proceeding if a hearing is granted on the petition of any other petitioner. The Memorandum and Order also denies the petitioners' procedural motions and reserves ruling on the remaining two antitrust-based petitions filed by other petitioners.
