Subject: Docket No. 50-482: Committed Response to Generic Letter 95-07, "Pressure Locking and Thermal Binding of Safety-Related Motor Operated Gate Valves"

Gentlemen:

Reference 1 committed that Wolf Creek Nuclear Operating Corporation (WCNOC) would perform long-term corrective action for specific valves. The corrective actions were to be completed by the end of the 12th Refueling Outage, which ended April 27, 2002. The commitment stated: "As a long-term corrective action, WCNOC will either

- 1) Enhance the margin to meet the ComEd methodology acceptance criteria, or
- 2) Eliminate the motor operated valves' susceptibility to pressure locking."

As noted in Reference 1, WCNOC expected to accomplish the long-term corrective actions through modifications and/or procedure revisions. This commitment includes valves: EMHV8801A/B, EMHV8802A/B, EMHV8803B, BBHV8000A/B, BNHV8812B, EJHV8804A/B, ENHV0001, ENHV0006, ENHV0012, ENHV0015, ENHV0016, EJHV8811A/B and EJHV8840. Reference 2 restated the commitment of long-term corrective actions that WCNOC planned to take.

WCNOC personnel have completed implementation of the long-term corrective actions and modifications to the motor operated valves listed above. Various change packages and work orders associated with the implementation are available for review at Wolf Creek Generating Station.

No further commitments are contained in this correspondence.


