I am writing to request that if possible, the ASLB hold the upcoming July 10 conference regarding BREDL/NIRS Amended Contention 2 at the offices of the NRC, instead of over the telephone as planned. I am making this request because Duke's and the Staff's combined responses to the amended contention are quite lengthy, and likely to require extended and complex discussion.
