Your letter of April 15, 1960 asked that the Advisory Committee be kept currently informed concerning the investigation and post-incident analysis of the recent incidents at GETR and ETR. The Commission has appointed Incident Investigating Committees to look into these occurrences, and we will advise you of their conclusions and recommendations when they become available. As you suggested to Dr. Beck, we have made preparations to give the Advisory Committee a brief oral summary of the available information on these incidents and any similar incidents at MTR and ETR at your forthcoming May meeting. Mr. Merson Booth is scheduled to do this.

We have previously sent to the Committee all information received from the licensee concerning similar releases which have occurred in the past at the GETR and GE-VBWR. We will continue to forward such reports to the Committee in the future.
