AMENDMENT NC. 2

Effective at 12:01 A.M., MAR 251963 , Indemnity Agreement No. B-18 between Westinghouse Electric Corporation and the Atomic Energy Commission dated June 18, 1962, as amended is hereby further amended by deleting Item 2a of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement in its entirety and substituting the following therefor:

Item 2a - Amount of financial protection -

\$250,000 from 12:01 A.M., November 25, 1957 to 12:01 A.M., June 19, 1959, inclusive; \$3,000,000 from 12:01 A.M., June 19, 1959 to 12:01 A.M., January 8, 1960, inclusive; \$9,000,000 from 12:01 A.M., January 8, 1960 to 12:01 A.M., May 7, 1960, inclusive; \$10,800,000 from 12:01 A.M., May 7, 1960 to 12:01 A.M., April 18, 1961, inclusive; \$12,600,000 from 12:01 A.M., April 18, 1961 to 12:00 midnight MAR 2 4 1963, inclusive; and \$1,000,000 subsequent to that date.
