#### AMENDMENT NO. 3

Effective at 12:01 A.M., April 24, 1963, Indemnity Agreement No. 3-18 between Westinghouse Electric Corporation and the Atomic Energy Commission dated June 18, 1962, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

Item 3 of the Attachment to the Indomnity Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted therefor:

"Item 3 - License master or numbers

CX-6, CX-11, TR-2"

Item 4 of the Attachment to the Indemnity Agreement is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted therefor:

"Item A - Location

The buildings and fenced area as shown in the drawing referenced below including the side sketch shown on the drawing but excluding (1) the hot cells in the Reactor Service Building and (2) that portion of Westinghouse's Critical Test Building formerly occupied by the facility licensed under License No. CX-16. The location is at Walts Mill, Pennsylvania.

#### NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF FACILITY LICENSE

Please take notice that on April 24, 1963, the Atomic Energy Commission terminated License No. CX-16 in its entirety and amended those sections of Indemnity Agreement No. B-18 which provided indemnity coverage for activities conducted under License No. CX-16. License No. CX-16 authorized Westinghouse Electric Corporation to operate its LRX critical experiment facility at its site near Waltz Mill, Pennsylvania. On April 8, 1963, Westinghouse requested that License No. CK-16 be terminated and advised the Commission that the facility was not in operation and all source, special nuclear and byproduct material authorized under License No. CX-16 had been disposed of in accordance with approved procedures. On April 24, 1963, Westinghouse entered into a contract with and for the account of the Commission for the operation of a critical facility at this location. Pursuant to Section 50.11(c), 10 CFR, Part 50, the operation of such a facility is exempt from the licensing requirements of the Commission.

Under the terms of this contract Westinghouse will receive indemnity coverage under Section 170 (d) of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, in the operation of this facility.

Accordingly, Indemnity Agreement No. B-18, as amended, does not provide coverage for the contract activities to be conducted in this facility.
