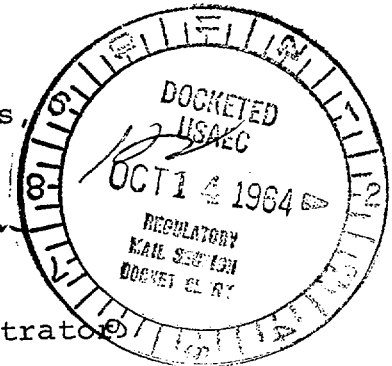

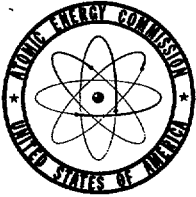

AMENDMENT TO INDEMNITY AGREEMENT NO. B-18

AMENDMENT NO. 6

Effective September 25, 1964, Indemnity Agreement No. B-18 between Westinghouse Electric Corporation and the Atomic Energy Commission dated June 18, 1962, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:

Delete Item 4 of the Attachment to the indemnity agreement in its entirety and substitute the following therefor:

Item 4 - Location

The buildings and fenced areas as shown in the drawing referenced below but excluding (1) the hot cells in the Service Building and (2) that portion of the building now designated Astronuclear which was formerly occupied by the facility licensed under License No. CX-16. The location is near Waltz Mill, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania.
