**SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO THE ISSUANCE OF ORDER FOR
INTERIM SAFEGUARDS AND SECURITY COMPENSATORY MEASURES
SALEM AND HOPE CREEK GENERATING STATIONS
DOCKET NOS. 50-272, 50-311 AND 50-354**

Dear Mr. Collins:

On March 15, 2002, and May 31, 2002, PSEG Nuclear, LLC, submitted letters in response to the Issuance of Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures that was issued by the NRC on February 25, 2002. The enclosed information submittal is forwarded to resolve two open issues from our docketed initial response to the Order and the subsequent supplement. PSEG Nuclear's position on one issue (Order element B. 2. b.) that was addressed in the Supplement has been modified to conform to the Order as clarified with the NRC Staff. The second issue (Order element B. 4. f.), was discussed and thought to have been resolved during a teleconference during the staff's initial review of our submittal. However, further consideration by the staff raised additional questions that PSEG Nuclear believes can be resolved by the information provided in this submittal. This information was discussed by PSEG Nuclear, LLC security management and NRC staff following the Industry/NRC Workshop held on June 13, 2002

The information that is included as an attachment to this letter provides additional detail concerning how PSEG Nuclear's response achieves the intended objectives of the order elements in question. PSEG Nuclear, LLC, considers the attached response to be Safeguards Information in accordance with 10CFR73.21.


