Subject: Byron Station Security Plan, Revisions 64 and 65.

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), "Conditions of licenses," we are submitting changes to the Exelon Generation Company, LLC, Byron Station Security Plan. In accordance with 10 CFR 50.4(b)(4), "Security plan and related submittals," attached are the original and three copies of Revisions 64 and 65.

Revision 64 includes the following change.

The Security Plan has been revised to allow for self-inspection of weapons to facilitate self-service weapons issuance and storage by on-duty security guards.

Revision 65 includes the following change.

The Security Plan has been revised to add alternate, NRC approved, methods for obtaining information pertaining to military records.

As required by 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), we have concluded that these changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the Byron Station Security Plan.

The changes made to the Byron Station Security Plan in Revisions 64 and 65 were implemented on April 30, 2002. In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), these changes shall be reported to the NRC within 60 days of implementation, i.e., June 29, 2002.
