**Supplement to License Amendment Request dated December 11, 2000
Conversion to Improved Technical Specifications (ITS)**

By letter dated, December 11, 2000, Prairie Island submitted a License Amendment Request (LAR) to convert the current Technical Specifications (CTS) using the guidance of NUREG-1431, Revision 1 as amended by NRC and industry Technical Specification Task Force (TSTF) documents. This letter supplements the subject LAR.

The NRC Staff, in meetings and telephone calls, has requested changes in the proposed Technical Specifications and additional documentation in support of this LAR. NMC has also identified other required changes to the submittal.

Attachment 1 to this letter provides additional information in response to NRC requests for additional information regarding: 1) steam generator capability to remove decay heat; 2) the heat flux hot channel factor and shutdown margin during physics tests methodologies submitted by letter dated January 25, 2002; 3) the Frequency for SR 3.2.1.2; and 4) Prairie Island's response to Generic Letter 99-02. The discussion of Generic Letter 99-02 does not include maximum filter test face velocities. The maximum test face velocity for each system is being evaluated. NMC will complete this evaluation and submit a license amendment request, if required, as discussed in Attachment 7, License Condition 3.

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Attachment 2, Page List by RAI Q, provides a cross-reference of change designators E53 through E60 to the changed pages.

Attachment 3 to this letter contains Revision 16 change pages. Changes to the Revision 16 pages are sidlined in the right margin beside the line(s) which have been revised. Change Pages from Parts A, B, D, F, G or Cross-References are dated 6/25/02. Change Pages from Parts C and E are marked as Revision 16 with a small textbox below the revision sideline which contains "R-16".

NMC has removed all revision side-bars and footer dates from the proposed improved Technical Specifications and Bases. This revision of the ITS is provided to the NRC in Attachment 4 with the NRC Amendment numbers included in the footer.

NMC submitted SER Tables with the supplement dated May 10, 2002. NMC incorporated NRC comments on these Tables and is submitting revised SER Table pages in Attachment 5.

By letter dated June 3, 2002, the NRC supplied NMC with the draft SE and requested comments by June 17, 2002. NMC provided comments to the NRC Staff in meetings on June 17, 2002. These comments also provided as Attachment 6 to this letter.

To support the conversion from current Technical Specifications to improved Technical Specifications, the additional conditions in Attachment 7 are proposed for Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant Facility Operating Licenses DPR-42 and DPR-60 (Appendix B).


