**MINUTES FROM THE MEETING BETWEEN**  
**THE U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION STAFF,**  
**WESTERN NUCLEAR, INC.**  
**JUNE 10, 2002**

On June 10, 2002, Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards and Office of General Counsel staff met with representatives from Western Nuclear, Inc. (WNI) in Denver, Colorado. This meeting was at the request of WNI to discuss its May 28, 2002, response to the NRC's request for additional information. This pertains to an on-going review of WNI's Groundwater Corrective Action Plan.

WNI and its consultant Shepard Miller basically gave an abstract of the May 28, 2002, submittal. Since the NRC had just received this report, no substantive technical discussions were conducted.
