Dear Dr. Silverman:

Enclosed for the information of the Advisory Committee are three copies of an amendment to 10 CFR Part 50, "Licensing of Production and Utilization Facilities," which, among other things, incorporates in Part 50 a definition of a "testing facility." It was published in the Federal Register in lieu of the amendment transmitted to Dr. McCullough by letter dated December 29, 1959. The enclosed amendment does not modify the substantive provisions of its predecessor; a minor change was made in the introductory portion of the new paragraph 50.2(r).

Also enclosed are three copies each of three proposed amendments to Part 50 which will be published in the Federal Register in accordance with the procedure allowing interested persons 60 days in which to submit to the Commission their written comments and suggestions. The three proposed amendments are designed to simplify and to clarify the procedures for issuance of reactor construction permits and operating licenses.
