NOTICE OF CONSIDERATION OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT
TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE AND PROPOSED NO SIGNIFICANT
HAZARDS CONSIDERATION DETERMINATION AND OPPORTUNITY FOR
A HEARING

Wisconsin Electric Power Company, Docket Nos. 50-266 and 50-301, Point Beach
Units 1 and 2, Town of Two Creeks, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin

Date of amendment request: June 4, 1976 as modified January 28, 1980.

Description of amendment: The amendments would permit operation after approval of changes to the plant's Technical Specifications (TS) that bring them into compliance with Appendix I, 10 CFR 50, and 10 CFR 50.36a and 50.34a. These proposed T.S. are intended to ensure that releases of radioactive material to unrestricted areas during normal operation remain as low as is reasonably achievable. Specifically, the proposed T.S. define limiting conditions for operation and surveillance requirements for radioactive liquid and gaseous effluent monitoring. Additional environmental sampling locations have been added to the present sampling locations. Additional managerial review responsibilities and reporting requirements have been added relating to radioactive releases. A site plan figure depicting the site exclusion area boundary has been added and the definition of channel check has been changed to more closely follow the recommended definition contained in NUREG-0472, "Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications for PWRs."

Basis for proposed no significant hazards consideration determination. The Commission has provided guidance concerning the application of the standards by pro-

viding certain examples (48 FR 14870). One of the examples of actions involving

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no significant hazards considerations relates to additional limitations, restrictions or control not presently included in the technical specifications (ii). In the case of the proposed technical specifications, they constitute an additional requirement for monitoring and control of radioactive effluents not presently in the technical specifications and are intended to meet the intent of the Commission's regulations (10 CFR 50 Appendix I, 10 CFR 50.34a, and 10 CFR 50.36a) and related staff guidance (NUREG-0472). Therefore, the staff proposes to determine that the amendments do not involve a significant hazards consideration.
