The Commission issued Amendment Nos. 161 and 165 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-24 and DPR-27 for the Point Beach Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. respectively, on March 6, 1995. The amendments revised the Technical Specifications (TS) in response to your application dated December 22, 1994, as supplemented by letters dated February 1, 1995, and February 21, 1995.

The amendments included changes to Item 13 of Table 15.4.1-1, page 2 of 6, of the Technical Specifications (TSs), as indicated by a margin bar on that page. A change was inadvertently made to Item 19, "Analog Rod Position." A monthly testing requirement was incorrectly inserted. This change was not addressed in your submittals or in the staff's Safety Evaluation. In fact, the monthly testing requirement was removed from this item as part of Amendment Nos. 140 and 144 for Units 1 and 2, respectively, which was issued on July 28, 1993. Amendments 157 and 161 for Units 1 and 2, respectively, issued on December 8, 1994 (the only other change to this page between the issuance of the above two amendments), did not include this testing requirement.

A copy of the corrected page 2 of 6 of TS Table 15.4.1-1 is enclosed, and should replace the current copy in your TSs. Please contact me if you have any questions regarding this issue.
