NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (the licensee) to withdraw its December 28, 2000, application, as supplemented September 20, 2001, and January 9, 2002, for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License No. 50-395 for the Virgil C.
