The symbol "YDO" has been assigned as the Reporting Identification Symbol (RIS) for reporting activities involving source and/or special nuclear material, as applicable, under U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) license number SNM-1999. This RIS is to be used only for **UNCLASSIFIED** transactions involving material at Kerr-McGee Operating Corporation's Cushing Facility, Cushing, Oklahoma.

The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has specified, in Sections 75.34, 74.15, 74.13, 70.54 and 40.64 of 10 CFR Parts 75, 74, 70 and 40, and in associated reporting instructions, requirements for submittal to the NRC of material transfer reports whenever certain transfers of special nuclear or source material occur. Reports are required for any transfer, receipt or inventory change of 1 gram or more of contained U-233, U-235 or Pu in special nuclear material, 1 kilogram or more uranium or thorium of foreign origin in source material, or the import of 1 kilogram or more of uranium or thorium of any origin.

The NRC utilizes an electronic data processing system to record these reports. All licensees subject to these reporting requirements have been assigned a RIS for identification. The RIS for the facility receiving nuclear material from or shipping nuclear material to your facility should be used in completing the transfer forms (DOE/NRC Form 741) in accordance with the instructions, and should be used in inventory reports and other correspondence with the NRC relative to such reports.
