JOINT REPORT OF PARTICIPANTS ON TIME NEEDED  
FOR ORAL ARGUMENT ON STANDING AND CONTENTIONS

Per Memorandum and Order (Request for Joint Status Report), dated July 22, 2002, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (“Board”) requested a brief joint report of the participants’ views as to how long will be needed for the prehearing conference scheduled for September 10, 2002, to hear oral argument on standing and contention admissibility. The NRC staff has undertaken to solicit the views of the participants and file the joint report.

On behalf of the NRC staff, Pacific Gas & Electric Company (“PG&E”), San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace(“SLOMFP”), San Luis Obispo County, and Port San Luis Harbor District, I am providing the following views of the participants.

The participants anticipate that no more than two days will be required for the prehearing conference, with one caveat. The Harbor District felt that more than two days might be required, if argument were required on its standing. The following additional views were provided:

1. PG&E believes that oral argument on all issues can be completed in one day, while considering it wise to schedule two days.

2. SLOMFP believes that as much as a day and a half may be required for oral argument on its clients' standing and their proposed contentions.

This comprises the views of all of the current participants in the proceeding.
