## DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FINAL RULE, "HAZARDOUS MATERIALS: RETENTION OF SHIPPING PAPERS" (STP-02- 060)

This is to inform you that the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) published the above subject <u>final rule</u> in the <u>Federal Register</u> on July 12, 2002. The rule requires shippers and carriers to retain a copy of each hazardous material shipping paper, or an electronic image thereof, for a period of 375 days after the date the hazardous material is accepted by a carrier. DOT has requested that we inform the Agreement States of this action. The rule becomes effective on August 12, 2002.
