By application dated January 25, 2002, you requested an amendment to Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 1015 for the NAC-UMS Universal Storage System. The application requests the incorporation of certain advanced design features to the NAC-UMS system. This is to inform you that the application contains the necessary information to begin our review.

You are hereby advised that any subsequent issue you identify that could affect the application must be submitted to the staff for review and approval as a supplement to the application.

Below is a schedule for review of your application. It is expected that the overall schedule will be reviewed and updated periodically as key milestones are reached and, as necessary, to appropriately reflect the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) casework prioritization.

Please note that the amendment review schedule relies on the completeness and accuracy of your application. Our identification of any issues during our technical review may have an impact on the schedule. To better serve your needs and those of all our stakeholders, we request that you provide any NAC-requested changes to this schedule in writing.
