- SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON JULY 18, 2002, WITH THE NUCLEAR ENERGY INSTITUTE (NEI) AND INDUSTRY AND STATE REPRESENTATIVES ON INTERIM SAFEGUARDS AND SECURITY COMPENSATORY MEASURES FOR INDEPENDENT SPENT FUEL STORAGE INSTALLATIONS (ISFSIs) USING DRY STORAGE
