Dear Mr. O'Clair:

As requested, we have reviewed the proposed regulations to the North Dakota Radiological Health Rules, received by our office on June 28, 2002. The proposed regulations are in response to the 17 amendments identified in the enclosed State Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. The regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC regulations in 10 CFR Parts 19, 20, 30, 31, 32, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, 61, 71 and 150. We discussed our review of the regulations with Ken Wangler on August 7, 2002.

As a result of our review, we have three comments and one editorial suggestion that have been identified in the enclosures. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that a State regulation meets the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulation may only be made based on a review of the final State regulation. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted incorporating the comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in STP Procedure SA-201, *Review of State Regulations* (November 10, 1998), please highlight the final changes and send one copy to STP in a computer readable format, if possible.

The SRS Data Sheet summarizes our knowledge of other North Dakota regulations. Please let us know if you note any inaccuracies or have any comments on the information contained in the SRS Data Sheet. The word badge is not defined in the North Dakota rules and even though the "badge" is commonly used in the industry, it is suggested that the term personnel dosimeter be substituted for the word badge for consistency.
