SUMMARY OF INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUEST

Title: 10 CFR Part 26, Fitness for Duty Program, Final

Current Burden/Responses:

61,575 hours/44,216 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses:

64,446 hours/1,514 responses (1,440 responses plus 74 recordkeepers)

Burden Attributable to Third-Party Collections: 1,719 hours

Frequency of Response: On occasion, Biannually

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses:

The burden for two Category I sites that are required to comply with 10 CFR Part 26 has been added to the clearance. Additionally, the burden for third-party collections in sections 26.27(a)(1) and (3) has been added to the package. The number of responses has decreased from 44,216 to 1,440 because the third-party notifications have been included as recordkeeping per OMB's guidance.

Abstract:

10 CFR Part 26, "Fitness for Duty Programs," requires licensees of nuclear power plants and licensees authorized to possess, use, or transport unirradiated Category I nuclear material to implement fitness-for-duty programs to assure that personnel are not under the influence of any substance or mentally or physically impaired, to retain certain records associated with the management of these programs, and to provide reports concerning significant events and program performance.
