1 compensation for services rendered and reimbursement of expenses incurred during the
2 Application Period.

3 2. The Firm billed a total of \$104,658.58 in fees and expenses during the
4 Application Period. The total fees represent 282.80 hours expended during the period covered by
5 this Application. These fees and expenses break down as follows:

11 Trustee and served by the fifteenth day of the month following the service of this Application. If
12 such an objection is filed, Debtor is authorized to pay the amounts, if any, not subject to the
13 objection. The Firm is informed and believes that this Cover Sheet Application was mailed by
14 first class mail, postage prepaid, on or about August 6, 2002.

15 9. The interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this
16 Application is on account and is not final. Upon the conclusion of this case, the Firm will seek
17 fees and reimbursement of the expenses incurred for the totality of the services rendered in this
18 case. Any interim fees or reimbursement of expenses approved by this Court and received by the
19 Firm will be credited against such final fees and expenses as may be allowed by this Court.

20 10. The Firm represents and warrants that its billing practices comply with all
21 Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local Rules and Compensation Guidelines and the
22 Guidelines of the Office of the United States Trustee. Neither the Firm nor any members of the
23 Firm has any agreement or understanding of any kind or nature to divide, pay over or share any

25 except as among the members and associates of the Firm.
