Dear Counsel:

On July 22, 2002, WorldCom, Inc. and its subsidiaries filed a chapter 11 petition in United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York. WorldCom, based in Clinton, Mississippi, provides communications networks services (such as internet related services and data services) and long distance telecommunications services. WorldCom provides many different services for various federal agencies, including data networks, telecommunications, and network management. We anticipate that WorldCom's bankruptcy case will implicate several governmental interests and that it will move quickly.

The Civil Division of this Office represents the United States and substantially all of its agencies in this case. We would appreciate it if you would notify us of the existence of any potential claims, rights or causes of action arising out of statute, common law or contract that your agency may have against WorldCom, including those that may result in your agency filing a proof of claim in this case. While no bar date for making claims has yet been set, the timely submission of claims is essential in order to protect the United States' interests.

We are also interested in any contracts your agency may have with WorldCom that are critical to fulfilling the agency's mission. Please also advise us of any significant contractual or other potential obligations owed to WorldCom, which could be important for setoff and other purposes. In addition, we would appreciate it if you would notify us of any regulatory interests that may be implicated by the bankruptcy filing.
