
Gentlemen:

This letter provides information in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2) concerning changes at Wolf Creek Generating Station (WCGS) affecting the WCGS Physical Security Plan, the Safeguards Contingency Plan, and the Security Training and Qualification Plan. Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Training and Qualification Plan**

**Reasons and Justifications**

**Change 1**

- Pages Affected:** Pages throughout the Physical Security Plan, Training and Qualification Plan, and the Contingency Plan.
- Change:** The title of Superintendent Security has been changed to Manager Security. The Manager Security reports directly to the Vice President Operations. The Superintendent Security previously reported to the Manager Resource Protection who reported to the Vice President Operations.
- Reason for Change:** Organizational changes within WCNOG have eliminated the position of Manager Resource Protection and implemented the title change from Superintendent Security to Manager Security.
- Justification:** No responsibilities have changed; only the titles discussed above and reporting relationship have changed. Therefore, this change does not reduce the effectiveness of the Physical Security Plan, the Safeguards Contingency Plan, or the Security Training and Qualification Plan.
