Enclosed for your information is the synopsis of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Office of Investigations (OI) completed report regarding the alleged deliberate falsification of background information by a contractor general foreman to obtain site access. OI did not substantiate that the contractor falsified a security questionnaire by failing to report an arrest.

We have reviewed the results of the OI activity and Station Administrative Procedure VPAP-0105 (Revision 15), "Fitness for Duty Program." SYNOPSIS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region II, Office of Investigations (OI), initiated this investigation on December 5, 2001, to determine if a general foreman in the Iron Department, Fluor-Global, a contractor for Surry Power Station, falsified a security background questionnaire and failed to report an arrest.

The evidence developed during this investigation did not substantiate that the general foreman falsified a security questionnaire. OI determined the general foreman did fail to immediately report an arrest, but no criminal intent was identified.
