Dear Mr. Feigenbaum:

On February 25, 2002, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Orders modifying the operating license for the Seabrook Station, Unit No. 1, to require compliance with the specified interim safeguards and security compensatory measures.

The NRC staff's letter of May 14, 2002, addressed your earlier response to the Orders and granted, in response to your request, an extension of time until June 17, 2002, for your submission of the required response for ICMs B.2.a(1), B.2.a(2), B.2.b, B.2.c, and B.4.g.

The NRC staff has reviewed your response to ICMs B.2.a(1), B.2.a(2), B.2.b, B.2.c, and B.4.g, submitted by your letter of June 12, 2002, and finds that you have satisfied the current reporting requirements of the Order.

The NRC will determine the effectiveness of your implementation of the ICMs through on-site inspections. I would like to remind you that, pursuant to Section III.C.2 of the Order, you are to report to the Commission when you have achieved full compliance with the requirements described in Attachment 2 to the Order.
