Apparently, the Governor's office called OEMA and asked questions stemming from a number of local newspapers running stories today about a potential plant outage. As a result, Allen Hiser and Doug Pickett spoke with her and answered a number of basic questions. Regarding a final decision, they told her that the staff expects to review the licensee's letter of November 30 and make our decision known within approximately a week.
