FALL 2002 CAMP MEETING

General Information

The Fall 2002 CAMP meeting will be held from October 31 through November 2 in Alexandria, Virginia, USA. The general meeting will be held on the first two days and the TPC Meeting will be held on the morning of the third day, if necessary.

Meetings will be held at the Holiday Inn Old Town Select in Old Town Alexandria. The hotel (web site - <http://www.oldtownhis.com/>) is located at 480 King Street in the heart of Old Town Alexandria. Be aware that there are two Holiday Inns in Alexandria. Make sure that you are staying at the Old Town Select on King Street. Each participant is responsible for arranging his/her lodging reservations. The following information is provided to assist you in making your travel arrangements and reservations. Please examine the information carefully.

Reservations/Rates/Cancellations

Reservations: Reservations are to be made by the individual directly with the reservation department of the Holiday Inn Old Town Select. When making reservations, prominently note that the reservation is for sleeping rooms associated with the "CAMP Group Meeting".

Rate:

The special reduced conference rate is \$150 plus tax (currently 10% plus \$1 occupancy) for a single or double room. If the government per diem rate is increased, the room rate will be increased accordingly.

Timing:

Early reservations are required. All reservations must be completed by September 30, 2002. Late reservations will have to pay a substantially higher nightly rate. Twenty rooms have been blocked for the CAMP meetings and these will be assigned on a first reserved, first taken basis. When making your reservation, please request the group rate for the "CAMP Group Meeting".
Guarantee: Your reservation request will be confirmed and guaranteed by using a major credit card. Most major credit cards are accepted for your convenience.

Cancellation Policy: In the event of a cancellation, you must cancel your reservation at least 24 hours in advance to prevent having to forfeit the non-refundable deposit. Make sure that you get a cancellation number.

Travel from the Airport:

The Holiday Inn Old Town Select offers complimentary shuttle service to and from Reagan National airport and the King Street METRO station (on the blue and yellow lines) between the hours of 7:00 AM and 10:00 PM. Courtesy phones are located at each baggage terminal at the airport. METRO pickup will be provided upon phone request.

From Dulles International Airport the Super Shuttle 1-800-258-3826, (or by Internet at web site supershuttle.com) goes to Alexandria. You do not need shuttle reservations from the airport - just show up at the Super Shuttle location at Ground Transportation (after midnight call 703-416-7884). The shuttle travels on demand - Super Shuttle approximate rates from Dulles are \$22 first person, \$10 each for additional persons. You do need a reservation 24 hours prior to departure from the hotel to the airport. Taxi and limousine services are also available at substantially higher costs.

Parking at the hotel is limited so driving to the hotel is not recommended. The current rate for parking is \$10.00 per day for overnight guests. For those guests attending a meeting who do not have overnight accommodations, the hourly rate is \$3.50 with a maximum charge of \$12.00.
