Completion of Items for the February 25, 2002, Order for Interim  
Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures

On February 25, 2002, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures (the Order) to all operating nuclear power reactor licensees. Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. (DNC) answered this Order (applies to Unit Nos. 2 and 3) by letters on March 15, 2002, (B18605) and March 18, 2002, (B18617). DNC provided additional information in letters dated May 9, 2002, (B18653) and July 18, 2002, (B18719).

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Millstone Power Station is in compliance with the conditions of the February 25, 2002, Order. Our actions to comply with the Order are described in the letters answering the Order and the letters providing additional information.

DNC recognizes that NRC and industry guidance on recommended methods for complying with the Interim Compensatory Measures within the Order continues to evolve. DNC will continue to evaluate and disposition this guidance as it relates to the Millstone Power Station.


There are no regulatory commitments contained within this letter.


