The NRC requested Virginia Electric and Power Company's (Dominion's) cooperation in the handling of classified information in their August 7, 2002 letter. Specifically, the letter requested that a location be provided inside the protected area for the NRC Resident Inspector to store classified information. Dominion has reviewed the options provided in the letter and has decided to select option 3.

Dominion will not move this security container or attempt to gain access to it without permission from the NRC. If the container is found unlocked and unattended, Dominion will immediately notify the resident inspector or the NRC Headquarters Operations Officer and guard the contents of the container until NRC personnel are present.
