Management Actions and Sanctions

Fifteen (15) positive tests resulted in the denial or revocation of unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor was determined to have attempted to substitute a pre-access specimen. The specimen registered an unexplained low temperature and the subsequent test for cause resulted in a positive test. The individual was denied unescorted access. (Adulterants and substitutions are not delineated on the performance data form.)

Events Reported

BYRON STATION

Management Actions and Sanctions

Eleven (11) positive tests resulted in the denial or revocation of unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor tested positive for adulterants on a pre-access test and was denied unescorted access. (Adulterants and substitutions are not delineated on the performance data form.)

Events Reported

CLINTON POWER STATION

Management Actions and Sanctions

Twenty-three (23) positive tests resulted in the denial or revocation of unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor refused to re-test after being informed that the specific gravity of a pre-access specimen was determined to be too low. The individual was denied unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor tested positive for adulterants on a pre-access test and was denied unescorted access. (Adulterants and substitutions are not delineated on the performance data form.)

Note on Cutoffs

On May 1, 2001, the initial cutoff for marijuana was changed to 50 ng/ml for all individuals except for licensee bargaining unit personnel whose initial cutoff remains at 100 ng/ml.

Management Actions and Sanctions

Seven (7) positive tests resulted in the denial or revocation of unescorted access.

Events Reported

LASALLE COUNTY STATION

Management Actions and Sanctions

Sixteen (16) positive tests resulted in the denial or revocation of unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor refused to undergo a test for cause after a pre-access test specimen registered a temperature below the acceptable range. The individual was denied unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor was determined to have attempted to substitute a pre-access test specimen when it registered an unexplained high temperature. The individual was denied unescorted access. (Adulterants and substitutions are not delineated on the performance data form.)

Events Reported

QUAD CITIES NUCLEAR POWER STATION

Management Actions and Sanctions

Twenty-six (26) positive tests resulted in the denial or revocation of unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor refused to undergo a pre-access test and was denied unescorted access. One (1) short-term contractor tested positive for adulterants on a pre-access test and was denied unescorted access. (Adulterants and substitutions are not delineated on the performance data form.)

Events Reported

NUCLEAR GENERATION GROUP WARRENVILLE

Management Actions and Sanctions

No positive tests reported.

Five hundred sixty-two (562) negative quality control specimens tested on-site were submitted to the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration laboratory during this period. All five hundred sixty-two (562) specimens were confirmed negative by the laboratory.

Blind performance testing was conducted at a rate of ten (10) percent. Thirty-eight (38) specimens were submitted to the laboratory. All results were reported correctly.

Ninety-eight (98) positive test results were confirmed positive by the medical review officer.

Events Reported

There were no 24-hour reportable events during the period.

Additional Information

During the current reporting period, i.e., January-June, 2002, twenty-eight (28) specimens were reported as presumptive positive for cocaine as a result of on-site screening. Twenty-six (26) of the twenty-eight (28) specimens were confirmed as positive by the laboratory and were verified as positive by the Medical Review Officer for a confirmation rate of 92.9%.

During the current reporting period, i.e., January-June, 2002, seventy-one (71) specimens were reported as presumptive positive for marijuana as a result of on-site screening. Fifty-nine (59) of the seventy-one (71) specimens were confirmed as positive by the laboratory and were verified as positive by the Medical Review Officer for a confirmation rate of 83.1%.
