SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON AUGUST 8, 2002, WITH GE

NUCLEAR ENERGY (GENE) REGARDING BOILING WATER REACTOR (BWR) STABILITY RELATED POWER OSCILLATIONS

On August 8, 2002, representatives of GENE met with the NRC staff to present their proposed solution to the BWR stability related oscillations. The meeting was closed to the public due to the discussion of proprietary information. A representative from Carolina Power & Light Company also attended the meeting.

GENE gave an overview of the stability issue. The presentation covered their processes, methods, and evaluations regarding their solution to stability related power oscillations. They stated that GENE and the BWR Owners Group (BWROG) were determining a solution in parallel. The staff inquired if GE knew why the BWROG was pursuing a different approach. GENE was not sure. GENE stated that with the resolution of this issue they would be able to close out the Part 21 notification. They noted that the solution is only applicable to their current fuel line. The staff inquired if the solution will be part of GESTAR. GENE stated that it would.

The staff noted that GENE has several topical reports submitted for staff review. The staff noted that our resources are limited. The staff would like GENE to inform us of what their expectations are for the review of the currently submitted topical reports. GENE stated they would inform us by letter regarding their priorities. The staff stated that they would like to visit GENE as part of the review for this topical report.
