On February 25, 2002, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued an Order that modifies the operating license for Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant (PINGP) to require compliance with the specified interim safeguards and security compensatory measures.

The Order required certain actions be taken by the Nuclear Management Company, LLC (NMC) at PINGP within 20 days of issuance of the Order. PINGP submitted the 20-day response to the Order via letter dated March 18, 2002.

All requirements of the Order were fully implemented on or before August 31, 2002.
