51.22(c)(11)

By letter dated July 7, 1988, the General Electric Company-Morris Operation requested a Quality Assurance Program Renewal by issuing Quality Assurance Plan, NEDE-31559, to supersede Quality Assurance Plan, NEDO-20776, to reflect organizational changes within the General Electric Company.

The staff has concluded that this revision concerns minor administrative changes, and does not involve any changes in the scope or type of operations presently authorized by the license. Further, this revision meets the conditions that (i) there is no significant change in the types, or significant increase in the amounts of effluents that may be released offsite, (ii) there is no significant increase in individual or cumulative occupational radiation exposure, (iii) there is no significant construction impact, and (iv) there is no significant increase in the potential for, or consequences from radiological accidents.

Therefore, in accordance with 10 CFR 51.22(c)(11), an environmental assessment or an environmental impact statement is not warranted for this action.
