ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REGARDING RISK-INFORMED INSERVICE INSPECTION SUBMITTAL (TAC NO. MB4751)

By letter dated March 29, 2002, Nuclear Management Company (NMC and the licensee) requested relief from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff to use a risk informed inservice inspection program for the Duane Arnold Energy Center, instead of the existing American Society of Mechanical Engineers Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code, Section XI requirements for the selection and examination of Class 1 and 2 piping welds. On June 16, 2002, I sent an e-mail (Attachment 1) to Ms. C. Rushworth, NMC Licensing Engineer, with a draft request for additional information (RAI) on the relief request. On July 24, 2002, she replied by e-mail (Attachment 2), forwarding draft responses. On August 16, 2002, Mr. T. J. Kim (Backup PM) forwarded to NMC a followup RAI (Attachment 3) as a result of the NRC staff's review of the draft responses. In my subsequent phone call to Ms. Rushworth in late August 2002, she stated that NMC would document and provide written responses to these draft RAIs on or about September 6, 2002.
