SUBJECT: MODIFICATION NO. 4 TO TASK ORDER NO. 2 ENTITLED "TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW OF THE LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION FOR THE GENERAL ELECTRIC MORRIS OPERATION INDEPENDENT SPENT FUEL STORAGE INSTALLATION" UNDER CONTRACT NO.. NRC-02-00-010

Dear Ms. Hwang:

In accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Modification No. 4 to Task Order No. 2, to provide for a change in the level of effort and extension to the period of performance, as described in the attached Statement of Work. These changes are necessary since work on the request for additional information has been deferred. As a result, the cost ceiling for Task Order No. 2 is hereby increased by \$38,005.83 from \$328,205.79 to \$366,211.62. The sum of \$342,253.86 represents the reimbursable costs and the sum \$23,957.76 represents the fixed fee.

The Period of Performance for Task Order No. 2 is extended through 9/30/03. The following cost ceiling is established for the period specified:

The Contractor shall not exceed the established cost ceiling, during the specified period, without prior written authorization by the Contracting Officer.

The amount of obligated funds shall, at no time, exceed the task order ceiling. When and if the amount(s) paid and payable to the Contractor hereunder shall equal the obligated amount, the Contractor shall not be obligated to continue performance of the work unless and until the Contracting Officer shall increase the amount obligated with respect to this task order. Any work undertaken by the Contractor in excess of the obligated amount specified above is done so at the Contractor's sole risk.

This Modification No. 4 does not obligate funds.


