I served as a staff attorney in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Office of General Counsel, and on September 3, 2002, became an associate attorney at Winston & Strawn.

While working at the NRC, I performed some limited work on behalf of the NRC Staff in a proceeding involving Winston & Strawn's clients, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company ("Northeast Nuclear Energy") and Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc.
