Dear Mr. Lyman:

I am writing on behalf of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in response to your letter of August 30, 2002, concerning the Federal Register notice of July 31, 2002. That notice described the request for Amendment No. 03 to NRC license XSNM03171 to increase the amount of highly-enriched uranium (HEU) authorized for export to the NRU reactor in Canada. Although you do not object to approval of this particular amendment request, I understand that you have concerns about the impact of such an approval on the closely related matter of HEU supply for the MAPLE reactors in Canada. You also noted that you would detail concerns about the pending export license amendment request (XSNM03060) in a forthcoming letter to the Commission. That letter from you, dated September 13, 2002, has been received and a response is in preparation.

The NRC is conducting its review of these two export license amendment requests and consulting with the interested Executive Branch agencies as required. Your concerns will be considered in the ongoing review.
