To Whom It May Concern: Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant was designed to produce and then store a specific amount of nuclear waste, which it has done. At this time, the plant should be retired, as per the original plan. By producing more waste, PG&E would be putting our communities at great risk. Storage above ground of the spent uranium fuel rods in open-air concrete slabs would be an enormous target for terrorists, and would put our families in much greater jeopardy than with the present storage inside the security zone of the plant. 
