She confirmed that the mine in Sunrise closed in 1984 and that CF&I filed Chapter 11 bankruptcy in 1990. At that time, CF&I abandoned the property. The property went to the State of Wyoming in October 1991. She referred us to Bob McCannon, the former Supervisor of the mine in Sunrise. McCannon ((719) 561-3526) said that he personally remembered the gauge in question. When he wanted to dispose of the gauge, he remembered calling NRC and asking about proper disposal procedures. He clearly remembered making a purchase order, packing the gauge for disposal, and sending it to Texas in 1984.
