CFI Steel Corporation is Colorado Fuels & Iron Steel Corp.
Contacted Vicki Tagliafico, Public Affairs Officer ((503) 240-5226) for Oregon Steel Mills (OSM).
She stated that OSM is the parent company of CF&I. The mine in Sunrise was owned by CF&I,
but is shut down. CF&I went bankrupt in 1990s. At that time, OSM bought specific assets,
which did not include the mine. OSM has a Rocky Mountain Steel Mills Division (RMSM) based
in Pueblo, Colorado. Talked to Janet Boyd @ RMSM ((719) 561-6825). She confirmed that the
mine in Sunrise closed in 1984 and that CF&I filed Chapter 11 bankruptcy in 1990. At that time,
CF&I abandoned the property. The property went to the State of Wyoming in October 1991.
She referred us to Bob McCannon, the former Supervisor of the mine in Sunrise. McCannon
((719) 561-3526) said that he personally remembered the gauge in question. When he wanted
to dispose of the gauge, he remembered calling NRC and asking about proper disposal
procedures. He clearly remembered making a purchase order, packing the gauge for disposal,
and sending it to Texas in 1984.

Ralph Heyer @ ThermoMeasuretech indicated that information for Kay Ray devices pre-1980 is
pretty much nonexistent.

Cause of Bad Address/Lesson Learned:

Returned due to "insufficient address" and "out of business".

Mine closed in 1984 - property in Sunrise was abandoned by CF&I in 1990 after they filed Chapter 11 bankruptcy.
