

If the Contractor fails to meet the performance requirement for a service under surveillance by the method shown on the PRS, the NRC will calculate payment as follows:

The maximum task order payment per month for all services is multiplied by the maximum payment percentage for the specific service to determine the maximum payment for acceptable service.
