We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence, transmitting the FEMA final report for the April 9, 2002, radiological emergency preparedness plume pathway exercise at the Perry Nuclear Power Plant.

No deficiencies were identified during the exercise. However, two Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA's) were identified.

We fully recognize that any corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.
