Subject: Feedback from FENOC Meeting on CRDM and Shutdown

Commissioner,

Staff met with FENOC re: Davis Besse yesterday afternoon. Sam Collins was senior NRC member. Feedback I received was that meeting was productive -- a "good" meeting. After caucusing, the staff came back with 4 additional questions / requests:

- 1) Need a better understanding of compensatory actions - human error probabilities
- 2) CDF assuming plant is in the 95% column and assuming no credit for inspections (I am not sure what of context for this one)
- 3) Additional material heat / temperature effect information
- 4) Basis for a reduction of calculated CDF by a factor of 30 from last discussion

FENOC indicated that they could respond to 1, 2, and 4 immediately and would need some additional information from Framatome. They will provide the additional information by today.

Looks like they are converging on a shutdown date of February 16th. Looks like an Order is much less likely. Sam will make final decision by tomorrow (Friday).
