I. SECY-02-0151 - Private Fuel Storage (Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation)  
Docket No. 72-22-ISFSI; Review of LBP-02-08, Consideration under NEPA of  
Environmental Justice Issues

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to a grant of review of the Licensing Board ruling denying (in part) summary disposition of consideration of environmental justice issues under NEPA. The Memorandum and Order reverses the Board's partial denial of summary disposition on the environmental justice contention and directs the Board to grant summary disposition for PFS on this issue.

II. SECY-02-0154 - International Uranium (USA) Corporation (White Mesa Uranium Mill)  
(MLA-10/ Maywood Material) Appeal of LBP-02-12

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to an appeal by the Glen Canyon Group of the Utah Chapter of the Sierra Club (Sierra Club) of the Presiding Officer's decision in LBP-02-12 related to the International Uranium Corporation's license amendment proceeding. The Memorandum and Order affirms the Presiding Officer's decision to reject the Sierra Club's petition to intervene for lack of standing.
