## SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated on March 15, 2002, by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations, Region II, to determine if a Pinkerton, Inc., employee deliberately compromised the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA), Sequoyah Nuclear Plant (SQN) security officer entrance examination.

Based on the evidence developed, this investigation did not substantiate that a Pinkerton, Inc., employee deliberately compromised the TVA SQN security officer entrance examination.
