The NRC Office of Investigations (OI) initiated an investigation on May 10, 2002, to determine if an assistant radiographer working at Bruner's Island, York Haven, Pennsylvania, had been discriminated against for raising safety concerns. Specifically, the assistant radiographer alleged that he was terminated by Prime NDT on April 29, 2002, for advising you that he would not work with another technician who was drunk. The investigation concluded that the radiographer had not been discriminated against by Prime NDT as a result of raising safety concerns. A copy of the synopsis of the OI Report #1-2002-022 is enclosed.
