Dear Mr. Mehta:

This letter refers to your October 3, 2002 correspondence, in response to our September 4, 2002 letter and to the telephone discussion between Mr. Floyd Graham of your organization and Mr. Steven Courtemanche of this office on October 9, 2002. Your corrective actions for Item A in the Notice of Violation indicated that the "ECD encasing will be disassembled to find the ID number." However, it is our understanding from the October 9, 2002 telephone discussion that the dismantlement of the Electron Capture Detector will be limited to its removal from the gas chromatograph so that it can be examined to determine its serial number, as directed over the telephone by the manufacturer. Additionally, Mr. Graham was informed by Mr. Courtemanche, during the same telephone discussion, that it would not be necessary to send the leak test results to the Commission unless one of the Electron Capture Detectors was found to have removable contamination in excess of 0.005 microcuries. Thank you for informing us of the corrective and preventive actions documented in your letter. These actions will be examined during a future inspection of your licensed program.
