

SYNOPSIS

This investigation was initiated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations (OI), Region I, on May 10, 2002, to determine if a assistant radiographer, for Prime NDT (Prime), working at Bruner's Island, York, PA, had been discriminated against for raising safety concerns. Specifically, the assistant radiographer alleges that he was terminated by Prime on April 29, 2002, for advising the owner of the company that he would not work with another technician who was drunk.

Based on the evidence developed during this investigation, OI could not substantiate the allegation that the radiographer had been discriminated against by Prime as a result of raising safety concerns.
